Oklahoma City or OKC is the capital and largest city in the state. The city is the eighth largest by total area but 25th largest in total population in the U.S. Located in the Great Plains, OKC has one of the world's largest livestock markets. Its economy's largest sector is oil, natural gas, and petroleum, with the city built in the middle of an active oil field. The Federal government is a major employer, including workers at the Tinker AFB. OKC is home to two Fortune 500 companies - Devon Energy and Chesapeake Energy and by 2016, the metro area's GMP was \$73. billion. The city is home to the NBA's Oklahoma City Thunder, the National Cowboy & Western Hertiage Museum, and the Oklahoma City National Memorial, among other attractions.


